Duration	2 days (Initial or renewal)
Aims and Objectives	A training and assessment programme designed to clearly identify the skills and knowledge required by a competent person.
Scope	This programme is intended for operatives engaged in maintenance work in relation to LPG systems and equipment installed in or used with commercial vehicles.
Pre-Requisites	Candidates should have completed a basic health and safety course and possess a basic knowledge of LPG.
Training	<p>The training programme will utilise our Book 11 LPG Safety Commercial Vehicles training manual (100+ pages) and encompass the following topics:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Legislation, Regulations and Standards• Properties and characteristics of LPG• Combustion• LPG Storage• Gas supply controls• LPG Pipework• Gas safety and dealing with incidents involving LPG
Competence	The candidate's knowledge and understanding of the subject will be established by the application of multiple-choice theoretical assessments.
Assessment	The assessment will be conducted by an assessor qualified to A1 or equivalent standard.
Verification	The assessment process will be verified by an internal verifier qualified to V1 or equivalent standard.
Certification	The programme will be certificated by LPG Training. Certificates are valid for a period of three years. A certificate of competence will only be issued to successful candidates. Photo ID cards are available at extra cost.
